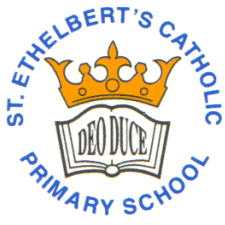

Planned spending for 2024-2025

Funding will be £19,500

Priorities for 24/25 are:

1. Membership of the Slough Schools Sports Network (£6000)
2. Provision of sports clubs (38 weeks) for vulnerable, hard to reach pupils.
3. Free clubs alternative to football. Improve sign up to clubs especially for PP pupils (£5000)
4. Participation in competitions and tournaments, travel to tournaments, any additional coaching, (£2,500)
5. Sport leadership training for children (£250)
6. New sport experiences for children (£2000)
7. Active promotion of lunchtime sports and games for all pupils, purchase of equipment including medals, provision of sports day (£3500)
